He became an international educator of anesthesia and critical care medicine in Asia after he completed the fellowship in cardiac anesthesia and transplantation anesthesia from Antwerp University Hospital, Belgium with the several publications related to hemodynamic and cardioprotection with total intravenous anesthesia versus inhalation anesthesia. He adapted his research related clinical experience to lead the tailor-made workshops and live demonstrations for numerous hospitals in Thailand and Southeast Asia and throughout Asia, to be able to perform up-to-date anesthesia techniques in their resources limited situations. He believes that all equipments and techniques are good if we know it very well, especially all limitations and know the tips and tricks for the preventable pitfalls. During his multi-cultural adaptation for workshops and lectures, it was not only the clinical improvement and research inspiration, but also the creation of social networking of happiness in anesthesia and the encouragement of work life balance with manpower limitation.

His PhD in medicine from Keio University Tokyo Japan was in cardiac output and hemodynamic monitoring, and his current research interests include hemodynamic monitoring and functional recovery after surgery. Because his university hospital is one of the outstanding hospitals in Thailand with plenty of new equipments and technologies, however, he always thinks about other anesthesiologists who may not be able to access to the advance techniques by always create the new platform, for example, from invasive to non-invasive practical fluid and hemodynamic management (GDEducAsia) or being the co-founder for many societies such as co-founder of the society of cardiac anesthesia of Thailand (SCAT) and society of transplantation anesthesia of Thailand (STAT) co-founder Asia Oceanic Community of Intravenous Anesthesia (AOCIVA), Co-founder and Executive Committee of Asia Anesthesia Forum (AAF), Co-founder and member of The International Federation of Intravenous Anesthesia (IFIVA). In addition, he tried to help and understand more by being awarded from the government of India (CSSR) to research in the cultural diversity of India "Sociological Barriers and Facilitators to Implementing Health Service Research of Goal-Directed Therapy for Enhanced Recovery After Surgery into Clinical Practice."

Currently, his responsibility is also the international cooperation and strategies planning of the council of the graduate studies of administrators of the whole country of Thailand. This made he gained experience in working with all other faculties in all Thai-international universities especially for the multi- and interdisciplinary studies development. All of this information summarized from part of his works. This indicate that he is full fill for the collaborative work, and he is always willing to connect and work for others.
